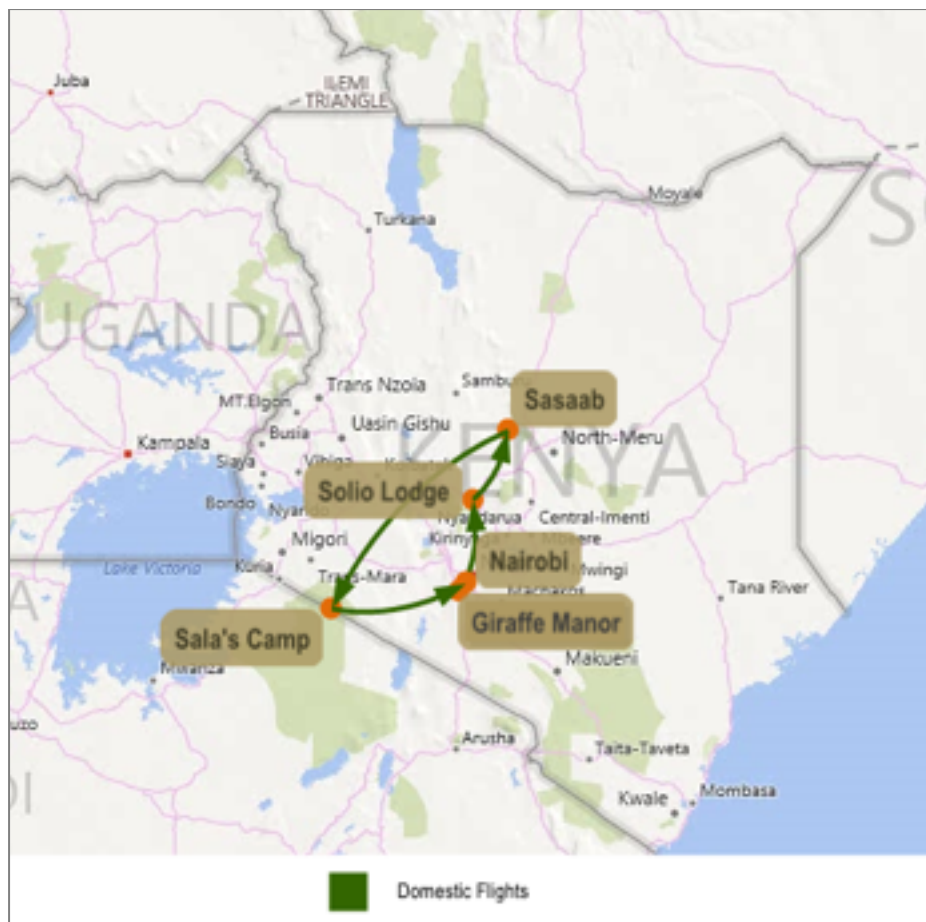

BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

- In order to confirm a booking, a 30% non-refundable deposit is required
- Balance payment is due 60 days prior to start date
- For flights and gorilla trekking permits, 100% payment is due immediately

CANCELLATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All cancellations must be advised of in writing
- For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
- For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
- For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)



INSURANCE

- Bush Butlers strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans
- Bush Butlers will not be liable for any costs resulting from any traveller's failure to purchase sufficient travel insurance

LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS ON LIGHT AIRCRAFT

Many itineraries include light aircraft flights. Please note that these flights have very strict luggage restrictions. Please take note of the following:

East Africa:

- Bags must be **completely soft sided**. At present, bags with frames and wheels are accepted, provided the rest of the bag is soft.
- The weight limit is **15 kg per person**. This **includes hand luggage**.
- Extra weight allowance can be purchased in advance.

If your bags do not fit the requirements, you may be asked to purchase a suitable bag from the airline and repack your belongings into this.

ADDITIONAL REMARKS

- We may have to reroute the itinerary or accommodate in similar lodges in case of non-availability at the time of booking
- Prices for domestic flights, airport taxes or park fees may be changed without prior notice. This is beyond our control and any increase levied will be passed to you

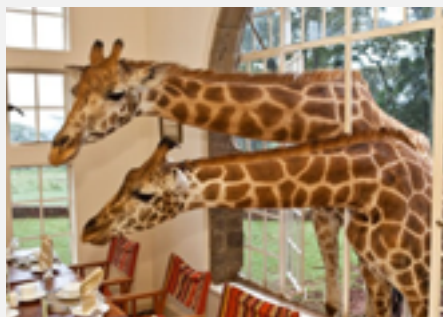
DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

Day 01

Arrive in Nairobi

After landing in Kenya at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi (**arrival flight not included in quotation**) you will be met and transferred to **Giraffe Manor** where you spend **1 night** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

1 night (all meals and drinks)



Giraffe Manor

Giraffe Manor is set in 12 acres of private land within 140 acres of indigenous forest 20 kilometres from Nairobi city centre. Built in the 1930s, this luxury boutique hotel has maintained all the charm of the era and is now famous for its resident herd of Rothschild Giraffe. Giraffe Manor offers you an unparalleled experience of the giraffes, with them vying for your attention at the breakfast table, the front door and even your bedroom window. Inspired by the manor's original 1930's decor, the 6 double bedrooms have been designed with large 4 poster beds, antique furnishing, striking art decor and spacious bathrooms.



Nairobi

Kenya's capital city has risen from a highland swampland called Ewaso Nai'beri – the place of cold – by the local Masai. When railway workers reached this area in 1899, they set up a basic camp and supply depot. The camp became a rustic village, and then a shanty town, which by 1907 was the capital of all of British East Africa. It was soon an important centre for the colony and a mecca for adventurers, hunters and travellers from all over the world. Modern Nairobi is still the safari capital of the Africa, and has become one of Africa's largest and most interesting cities.



Day 02

Nairobi ~ Laikipia

After breakfast you will be transferred to Wilson Airport to fly to the Solio Game Ranch where you will spend **2 nights at Solio Lodge on a fully inclusive basis**. The afternoon will be available to enjoy some of the activities offered at the lodge.

2 nights (all meals and drinks)



Solio Lodge

Solio Lodge on the Solio Reserve, part of a private ranch, is in the valley between the dramatic slopes of Mount Kenya and the rolling peaks of the Aberdare Mountains. The lodge has 6 cosy and luxurious en suite rooms with panoramic views. Each room has a lounge area warmed by a corner fire, as well as large bathrooms with double sink, bath and shower. These rooms are designed for warmth (Solio is high in altitude and can be cold at night), as well as outdoor living with a deck for relaxation. In-room facilities and amenities are WiFi, hairdryer, fridge, kettle, and iPod docking station.

Laikipia

It is always gratifying when conservation efforts truly pay off, and the Laikipia Plateau is a place of much excitement! Originally extensive farmland, a huge effort has succeeded in reclaiming much of the land between the slopes of the Aberdares and the snowy peaks of the mighty Mount Kenya. The area now boasts the second highest concentration of wildlife in Kenya - the Masai Mara topping the list! Divided up into private concessions, the Laikipia Plateau consists of accommodation in tented camps, as well as lavish bush homes, allowing for a wonderful personalised experience.



Day 03

Laikipia

For the full day you will be able to participate in some of the many activities offered, including guided walks, mountain biking, horseback riding, as well as game viewing.



Day 04

Laikipia ~ Samburu, Shaba, and Buffalo Springs

Today you will take a charter flight to Samburu, where you will spend **3 nights** at **Sasaab** on a **fully inclusive basis**. The afternoon will be spent on one of the many and varied activities offered by the camp.

3 nights (all meals and drinks)



Sasaab

Situated on a rocky ridge above the banks of the mighty Ewaso Nyiro river in north-central Kenya, in the heart of Samburu land, Sasaab is the only lodge in the vicinity and the safari experience is all the more spectacular for the location's wildness, in an area renowned for its variant species. The architecture of Sasaab follows strong Moroccan design principles, in which African heat is of primary consideration. Each of the nine Moroccan-styled rooms is over 100m² with an enormous open-air bathroom and private plunge pool. From the veranda, you can take in the remarkable views across the Laikipia Plateau toward the jagged peak of Mount Kenya.

Samburu, Shaba, and Buffalo Springs

On the southern edge of Kenya's northern frontier region, the Uaso Nyiro River carves through the desolate lands, and provides life to the wonderful reserves of Samburu, Shaba and Buffalo Springs. The water is vital for the survival of the many animals found in this region, as well as for the local Samburu tribes who have settled in the area. Especially rewarding during the dry season, when the surrounding land is parched and cracked, these reserves play host to several unique species, and great numbers of predators. Being some of the more remote tourist destinations of Kenya, there is a great sense of adventure in visiting these reserves.



Day 05 & 06

Samburu, Shaba, and Buffalo Springs

For these two days you can explore the area with its astounding number of animals on a game drive or by camel, visit the local Samburu people, or opt for a guided walk and some bird watching, or perhaps relax at the Spasaab.

Day 07

Samburu, Shaba, and Buffalo Springs ~ Masai Mara Game Reserve

After breakfast you will be assisted on to a flight to Keekorok airstrip in the Masai Mara. You will be met at the airstrip and transferred to **Sala's Camp**, where you will spend **3 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**. You will go on a game drive this afternoon after settling in to your tented accommodation.

3 nights (all meals and drinks)



Sala's Camp

Sala's Camp is a tented camp situated in the southern, wilder corner of the Masai Mara Game Reserve, close to the confluence of the Sand and Keekerok Rivers – a geographical feature that attracts teeming wildlife. Seven tented rooms all have olive wood beds and en-suite bathrooms, with solar powered electricity. The Camp's interiors are elegant and comfortable, offering crisp white sheets, African throws and silken cushions. Typically, after a day's excursion, you'll return to meet up for sundowners by the campfire before enjoying dinner with your companions on a long dining table beneath the stars.

Masai Mara Game Reserve

It is no surprise that the Masai Mara ranks up near the top of most famous game reserves in the world. The land of the Mara is covered with herds of antelope, interspersed with prides of lions, journeys of giraffe, dazzles of zebra, and almost every other collective animal noun you can think of. The sightings are nothing short of fantastic, and it is definitely the park to visit to tick off your "wildlife of Africa" list. The scenery of the park is similar to the open plains of the Serengeti, although the Mara is dotted with more trees, and the game viewing is equal to, or can be better than, its southerly sister



Day 08 & 09

Masai Mara Game Reserve

For these 2 days you will enjoy the range of shared wildlife viewing activities offered by Sala's Camp, with game drives to see either the rich population of resident wildlife or the herds of migrating animals at the right time of the year.

Day 10

Day of Departure

You will fly out of the Mara after a morning activity, landing at Wilson Airport, where you will be met and transferred to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport to continue with your onward travel schedule.
